When I heard that I could participate in project Erasmus+ I was very happy. I had mixed feelings before the Croatian friend came, but after the first handshake the great week full of experiences started.


I'll tell you about the trip that was on Wednesday when we visited Arboretum in Borová hora and Zvolen castle.



Beseda s lesníkmi

Sme síce krajinou ktorá nepatrí rozlohou k tým veľkým, ale patríme ku krajinám ktorých väčšinu územia zaberajú lesy. Keďže témou tretieho projektového stretnutia, v rámci projektu Erasmus+, bol les, tak sme sa rozhodli žiakom piateho a siedmeho ročníka spestriť vyučovanie besedou s lesníkmi z Mestských lesov v Krupine a poľovníkmi z poľovného združenia, ktorá trvala dve vyučovacie hodiny. Žiaci sa dozvedeli veľa nových a zaujímavých informácií o lese. Diskutovali o lesných zvieratách, ktoré môžeme vidieť pri potulkách našimi lesmi, o ochrane lesa a o starostlivosti o les, o prikrmovaní lesnej zveri, hlavne v zimnom období, keď je v lesoch nedostatok potravy, pretože je prikrytá snehom.

Žiaci sa ďalej zaujímali aj o možnostiach, ako získať poľovnícky lístok, boli zvedaví na zážitky z poľovačiek, na zaujímavé úlovky a lesnícke trofeje, ktoré sa lesníkom podarilo uloviť.

Pretože žiaci siedmeho ročníka už pomaly uvažujú aj o tom na ktorú strednú školu sa prihlásiť, pýtali sa lesníkov aj na štúdium na strednej lesníckej škole.

Zaujímavou témou rozhovoru bol aj výskyt medveďa hnedého v našom regióne - o tom, čo robiť pri stretnutí s medveďom, keďže v našej oblasti v okolí Krupiny sa medveď hnedý pri svojom putovaní lesmi objavuje dosť často.

Rozprávali sa aj o vábení jeleňov, o jelenej ruji, mohli si prehliadnuť a dotknúť sa parohov jeleňa a daniela.

Často lesníkov príjemne prekvapili zaujímavými, niekedy aj vtipnými otázkami, ale určite potešil ich záujem o lesné zvieratá a o poľovníctvo.

CHORVÁTSKI ŽIACI A UČITELIA OPÄŤ V KRUPINE

Skončil sa týždeň plný krásnych zážitkov s chorvátskymi priateľmi . Bolo to už tretie stretnutie medzi partnerskými školami Osnovna škola Krapinske Toplice a Základná škola Jozefa Cígera Hronského Krupina v rámci projektu Erasmus Plus s názvom We are eco- friendly , v slovenčine Priatelíme sa s ekológiou. Naše stretnutia sa začali v októbri 2018 v Krupine témou Voda, pokračovali v Chorvátsku v máji 2019 témou Znečistenie vzduchu a svetlom a tretie stretnutie s názvom Les sa konalo opäť v Krupine od 6. októbra do 11. októbra 2019.

Chorvátsky tím tvorili traja učitelia : Ivan Vrankić (fyzika a chémia), Martina Kunštek Smiljanec (anglický jazyk), Sanja Halapir (biológia) a piati žiaci vo veku prevažne 13 rokov : Jelena Čavlek, Rania Gerdin, Marta Svažić, Nina Crljen a Nino Besednik, ktorý jediný zastupoval chorvátskych chlapcov. Ich partnermi z našej školy boli žiaci Alžbeta Nevolná, Annamária Packová, Ema Cibulová, Michaela Krupová (všetky z 8.B) a Šimon Troiak (9. C). Komunikačným jazykom projektu je angličtina, takže okrem rozširovania poznatkov v oblasti ekológie sa žiaci a učitelia zlepšovali aj v konverzácii v anglickom jazyku.

Naša skupina prevzala svojich chorvátskych kamarátov do rodín v nedeľu podvečer. V pondelok sa s nimi stretli 4 triedy na druhom stupni a besedovali o voľnom čase, o meste Krapinske Toplice, o Osnovnej škole v ich meste, o rodinách, o ich vysnívanej krajine, obľúbených predmetoch v škole , chorvátskych jedlách a sviatkoch. V utorok chorvátski a slovenskí žiaci pripravili pre 5 tried našej školy svoje vystúpenia v angličtine na témy les, lesné zvieratá, stromy, chránené rastliny, Chorvátsko – krajina orchideí, zeleň v Krupine a ukázali našim žiakom dve videá z aprílových akcií 2019 : sadenie kvetov a byliniek v areáli chorvátskej školy a vysádzanie 150- tich stromčekov v lese v blízkosti Krupiny . V stredu sme absolvovali poldenný výlet. Navštívili sme botanickú záhradu Arborétum Borová Hora, nákupné centrum Európa a zámok vo Zvolene. V štvrtok sme na škole mali besedy s lesníkmi v piatom a siedmom ročníku. Chorvátski žiaci a ich slovenskí kamaráti sa dopoludnia venovali tvorbe plagátov v troch jazykoch : chorvátskom, slovenskom, anglickom a pripravili prehľad chorvátskych a slovenských stromov, lesných zvierat , vtáctva. Šesť zaujímavých plagátov sme vystavili vo vestibule školy. V piatok prišla rozlúčka, boli aj slzy a dojatie na oboch stranách.

Poobedné programy pre chorvátskych žiakov boli tiež zaujímavé. Slovenskí žiaci ukázali chorvátskym kamarátom historickú vežu Vartovka, hrad Bzovík, Banskú Štiavnicu, kde symbolicky "zamkli" naše stretnutie Erasmus plus a všetci sa na pamiatku podpísali, že mesto spolu navštívili, tiež si pozreli kaštieľ v Svätom Antone, priehradu Bebrava pri Krupine, zašli spolu na bowling a na štadión v Krupine. Výborné kamarátske vzťahy upevňovali na spoločných raňajkách u Betky a na čaji u Šimona. Nie je prekvapením, že chorvátskych žiakov najviac nadchol výhľad z Vartovky a krásna priehrada Bebrava. Podobne sme sa snažili spestriť program pre učiteľov z Chorvátska – v pondelok sme ich pozvali na wellness popoludnie do Dudiniec, v utorok na návštevu Banskej Bystrice. Obdivovali pohľad z hodinovej veže a keď z nej zostupovali, hrala im o štvrtej Mozartova Malá nočná hudba. Vo štvrtok nám prialo počasie. Asi pätnásť kolegov sa vydalo na prechádzku do dubového lesa Gavurky pri Dobrej Nive. Nádherné miesto na oddych všetkých nabilo pozitívnou energiou. Štvrtkový podvečer sme ukončili na chate Šváb pri Krupine ochutnávkou výborného guľáša, ktorý nám navaril pán školník a špecialít, ktoré priniesli mnohí kolegovia spolu s dobrou náladou.


